

# Tuition Fees



## **Rates:**

Registration Fee: \$40.00 per child reassessed annually in July. In the event you decide to withdraw and then re-enroll at a later date, you will be charged a new registration fee.

1 Class per week: \$54 per month

2 Class per week: \$93 per month

3 Class per week: \$127 per month

4 Class per week: \$156 per month

UNLIMITED: \$180 per month

**Family Rate: 10% off 1st sibling; 20% off each additional sibling (tuition only)**

**Referral Credit: Any new dancer who enrolls with your name given as a referral... awards you 20% off the following month tuition.**

**Combo Package (TBJT Classes):** \$83 per month for two classes a week

**Adult Dance Classes:** \$13.5 per class, due prior to participation

## **Performing Groups: Tot, Sassy, Hot, Crew (Teacher Approval)**

Performing/Tech: \$100 \*MANDATORY\* per month

Performing/Tech + 1 classes: \$134 per month

Performing/Tech + 2 classes: \$163 per month

Performing/Tech +3 or more classes: \$188 per month

## **Lil Bots/Mega Bots and Mini Spots:**

One-time annual fee of \$145

## **Discounts: 1 Discount per Account**

6 months paid in advance: receives 15% off (tuition only)

Gas discount: 10% off for families traveling 15 miles (or more) one way to studio (tuition only)

Military Discount: 10% off (tuition only)

## **Tuition Policies:**

Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month. A Late Fee of \$15.00 will be charged for any payments made after the 10th of the month.

Credit card payment or automatic withdraw is available. We find this option to be very convenient for both parents and staff. However, after 2 late tuition payments this option will become mandatory for your account. We accept Master Card, Visa and Discover. No American Express please. **We do not accept checks.**

When enrolled, every dancer has a permanent spot in the class indefinitely, or until the end of the dance year after summer recital. Due to limited class space, if a dancer misses 3 consecutive classes (without notification), "The Dance Spot" reserves the right to automatically withdraw student from classes to create space for new students. Any past dues on account will still remain and be due immediately. **Withdrawal from classes requires a call, written or email notice before the first of the month.**

**Full tuition is charged monthly regardless of whether there are 3, 4, or 5 weeks in that month. Full tuition is always charged monthly regardless of dancer's absences. There are no Refunds or deductions for classes missed. Make-up classes are available.**

\*All classes subject to class size and availability. Students will not be allowed into class if tuition is not paid.

## **Recital Information:**

We have two annual recitals at the Dance Spot, our Holiday Show in December, and our Summer Recital in June.

**Holiday Show:** We do not order costumes for our Holiday Show. We have you come up with your own after being given assigned colors. There will be a Holiday Recital Fee of \$40 per dancer. Tickets will be sold for \$14.

**June Recital:** In November, we will post the costume and recital participation fee to all accounts (costume fees: \$70 for combo kids, \$80 for child sizes, and \$90 for adult sizes. Each dancer will also need to pay a recital fee of \$40, and 10% off for first sibling and 20% off for second sibling.) These fees will be due February 1st. Once our bulk order for costumes is placed in February, there will be an additional \$20 late order fee on any costume ordered past this date. Tickets will be \$16.

Both Recitals are optional. Please advise the front desk if you choose to not participate and all fees will be removed from your account. However once paid, all recital and costume fees are non-refundable.

# The Dance Spot Registration Policies



- \* Please try to arrive to class on time. It is extremely disruptive to interrupt after classes have begun, especially for the younger classes. You may be asked to wait for the appropriate time to enter class.
- \* It is absolutely fine to drop your child off for their allotted dance class/classes and pick up after they're finished dancing. However, this applies to dancers taking class **ONLY**. **DO NOT** leave siblings unattended in the lobby. The front desk/ The Dance Spot will not be responsible for unattended children.
- \* A \$40 registration fee will be assessed at enrollment. This fee is applied to insurance and bookkeeping. The registration fee will then be assessed annually, every July. In the event you decide to withdraw and then re-enroll at a later date, you will be charged a new registration fee.
- \* Tuition is due the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. A \$15 late fee is assessed on the 11<sup>th</sup> of each month. Auto withdrawal is available for those who wish to take advantage. You may choose any withdrawal date between the 1<sup>st</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- \* After 2 late tuition payments there will be a mandatory requirement for monthly auto withdrawal for your tuition.
- \* When enrolled, every dancer has a permanent spot in the class indefinitely, or until the end of the dance year in June. Dancers may change or add classes throughout the year via the front desk. However, **to withdraw from a class or classes, a written notice or email must be given, and needs to be delivered before the 1st of the month before the following months tuition is processed.**
- \* Full tuition is charged monthly regardless of whether there are 3, 4, or 5 weeks in that month.
- \* **Full tuition is always charged monthly regardless of dancers' absences.**
- \* **There are no refunds or deductions for classes missed.** Make-up classes are available for active students only.
- \* Once a dancer has missed 3 classes in a row without notification, we reserve the right to un-enroll dancer.
- \* All payments are applied to the oldest balance first (this includes any late fees incurred).
- \* We do not accept checks
- \* **All payments are final, no refunds**
- \* The account must remain current in order to participate in classes, recitals, and make-up classes.
- \* The Dance Spot does not have a drinking fountain at this time. Please bring water bottle to class. No juices or Gatorades! If your dancer forgets, we do have water for sale at the front desk for \$1.00.
- \* I hereby release "The Dance Spot" and all staff members from all claims of damage or injury suffered by the above registered dancer in connection with or by their association with The Dance Spot. This includes my heirs who may not act in my behalf. (Note: Each student should be covered under some kind of individual policy. The Dance Spot will not be held responsible.)

## Code of Conduct Guidelines:

All dancers and parents will adhere to a certain code of conduct while enrolled at The Dance Spot. Dancers will be RESPECTFUL to their teachers and peers. Bullying of any kind will not be tolerated. Our procedures and rules are laid out very clearly in order to provide a structured learning environment. Distractions or behavior that affects the learning process and or other students/parents, will have to be addressed. If there is ever a conflict, the situation should be taken up with management and/or owner. If management feels the Code of Conduct Guidelines have been breached, The Dance Spot reserves the right of refusal for your patronage.
